





Notice of Race for the OK Inland Championships at Burton Sailing Club on 4th & 5th November 2023

1. Rules

- 1.1. The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the Event Supplementary Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Competitors should note that Burton Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book.
- 1.3. By entering into this event, you will be a temporary member of Burton Sailing Club for the duration. You will therefore be governed by the club rules and bye laws as published on our website.

2. Advertising

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. Conditions of Entry

- 3.1. The race is open to any OK Dinghy
- 3.2. Entrants must be members of the Class Association at the time of entering.
- 3.3. Entry fee will be £35.
- 3.4. Eligible helms may enter on the day, but pre-registration is requested via https://forms.office.com/r/PX2tkSwd1Q

4. Schedule

- 4.1. The first race start times for each day are scheduled to be as follows with the warning signal being 5 minutes prior to the start time.
- 4.2. Launching to commence up to 30 mins before the first race start time. A green Flag will be flown adjacent to the slipway when launching is permitted)
- 4.3. The racing schedule below may be amended on the days by the PRO in consultation with Class Association.

4.4. On the last schedules day of racing no warning signal will be made after 14:00

5. Scoring

- 5.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series and there will be one discard if Six races have been completed and no discards if less than six races are completed.
- 5.2. The low points system as provided in RRS Appendix A will apply

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1. The Event Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be available on the OK Class and BSC websites and one hour before the first briefing, on the Official Noticeboard. No paper copies will be provided to competitors.

7. Prizes

7.1. Prizes will be awarded by the OK Class commensurate with the size and spectrum of the entry.

8. Disclaimer

8.1. Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The OK Class Association and the organising authority (Burton Sailing Club) will not accept any

9. Insurance

9.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid Third-Party Liability Insurance with a Minimum Cover of £3 million.

NOTICE TO ALL VISITORS - Invasive Species Procedure.

Before launching, all competitors are required to ensure that – your boat has been 'Checked, Cleaned and Dried' for a minimum of two days prior to arriving at Burton Sailing Club.

ACCOMMODATION

Free camping for tents and caravans is available on site for 1 night before the event and any nights in between a joined day

Please note we do not have waste disposal facilities.

Dogs are allowed on site but must be under control at all times and are not permitted in the clubhouse or training centre

SITE ACCESS & PARKING
