



**Notice of Race for the 2025 Interclub**  
at  
**Burton Sailing Club**  
on  
**1<sup>st</sup> June 2025**

**1. Rules**

- 1.1. The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the Event Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Competitors should note that Burton Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.3. By entering and attending this event, all persons agree to abide by the Rules of Burton Sailing Club.

**2. Conditions of Entry**

- 2.1. The race is open to any dinghy with a PY of 896 or more.
- 2.2. There is no entry fee but entry is restricted to fully paid-up members of Burton SC, Staunton Harold SC and Swarkestone SC

**3. Schedule**

- 3.1. A briefing will be held at 10.30am on the day of the event. The briefing will at the clubhouse.
- 3.2. The 1st warning signal shall not be before 11.25am.
- 3.3. 3 races are intended. Race times are subject to change and any variation will be posted on the Official Notice Board outside the front of the clubhouse.
- 3.4. On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 16:00

**4. Sailing Instructions**

- 4.1. The Event Sailing Instructions will be available on the BSC website and one hour before the first briefing, on the Official Notice Board. No paper copies will be provided to competitors.

**5. Scoring**

**5.1. Individual Race**

- 5.1.1. One race to be completed to constitute a series. If all three races are sailed there will be one discard. If less than three races are sailed there will be no discards.
- 5.1.2. Scoring will be based on 2025 RYA PYs. Class association defined variations are also applied for older Flying Fifteens. PYs applied will be visible in the published results.

**5.2. Interclub race**

- 5.2.1. Number of boats to count in each club's team "N" is 75% of the smallest club fleet entries (subject to a minimum of 5 boats to count).
- 5.2.2. Teams with less than 5 boats will score DNCs for the shortfall.
- 5.2.3. A club's team score will be the summation of the club's lowest "N" individual race results scores.

**6. Disclaimer**

- 6.1. Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority (Burton Sailing Club) will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained prior to, during, or after the event.

- 7.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid Third-Party Liability Insurance with a Minimum Cover of £3 million.

## 8. Further Information

NOTICE TO ALL VISITORS - Invasive Species Procedure.

Before launching, all competitors are required to ensure that – your boat has been '**Checked, Cleaned and Dried**' for a minimum of two days prior to arriving at Burton Sailing Club.

This includes:

**CHECK** your equipment and clothing for live organisms – particularly in areas that are damp or hard to inspect.

**CLEAN** and wash equipment, footwear and clothing thoroughly. If you do come across any organisms, leave them at the water body where you found them.

**DRY** all equipment and clothing – some species can live for many days in moist conditions. Make sure you don't transfer water elsewhere.

Please note we do not have waste disposal facilities.

Dogs are allowed on site but must be under control at all times and are not permitted in the clubhouse or training centre.

### SITE ACCESS & PARKING

The car park nearest to the club house is for fishermen and visitors. Cars are permitted within the dinghy park to allow dropping or collection of boats and equipment but must be **removed immediately** to a designated car parking area.

### GALLEY

The Galley will be serving food including breakfast from 9:30 and Lunch between the races. Hot & cold drinks will be available throughout the day. Please order lunch at registration. The bar will be open after racing each day.
